Dave Stilwell has had enough of this total lack of respect, harassment and all around crap from Metro and has decided to do something about it. Through his research Dave has come up with a way to sue not only the department and the department heads but also the officers that are a part of the violation of your rights. I am sure that Metro reads these articles for their Intel so I won't go into any more detail than that but what I can tell you is that this is your time to stand up and put a stop to this treatment once and for all.
