More good news from the folks at Guerrilla Lawfare about the helmet law, Travis Barrick, who just ran for Attorney General in Nevada and Don Chairez, who ran for Clark County District Attorney, have both expressed interest in our battle to ride free in Nevada. These are two dedicated people that will need our support. It has been proven in the past that there are never too many directions on which to attack this issue. I believe that by attacking it on the legal front as well as the political front we will win and again be free in Nevada to have a choice.

NHTSA has finally got some people that have the ability to do simple math problems and have put out the report for the year and have come up with reduced fatalities in our state by 25% only to be led by Florida and Texas in the reduction of motorcycle fatalities, both of who have repealed the MANDATORY helmet laws in their states. This is the break we have been looking for and I believe that it is in part due to increased motorcycle awareness and education for all drivers.

All of this good news makes me feel like I got my own special Christmas present and it really makes me feel good, now if for my birthday we can have the repeal of the helmet law I wouldn't know what to do with myself.
